As much as we try to make the world wireless, there are still a few loose cables and cords dangling around most homes. Cover up the evidence with these handy items.

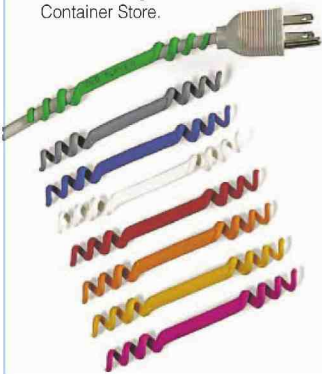
■ Cable Pop attaches to device via suction and provides storage for earbuds. **\$9.95** at Crate & Barrel.
