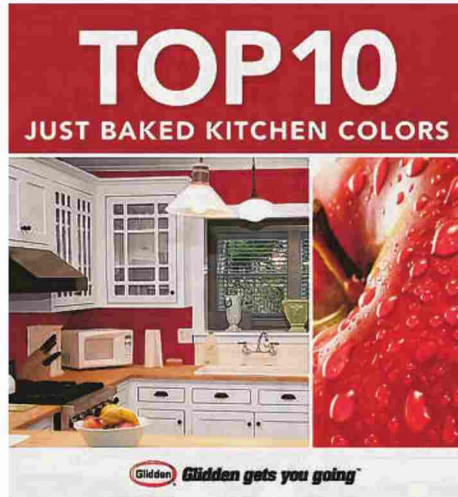
Tasty colors

Need we say more?



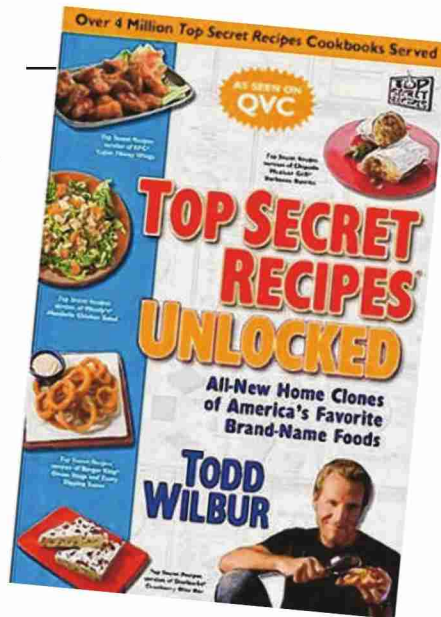
